

Welcome to Grant

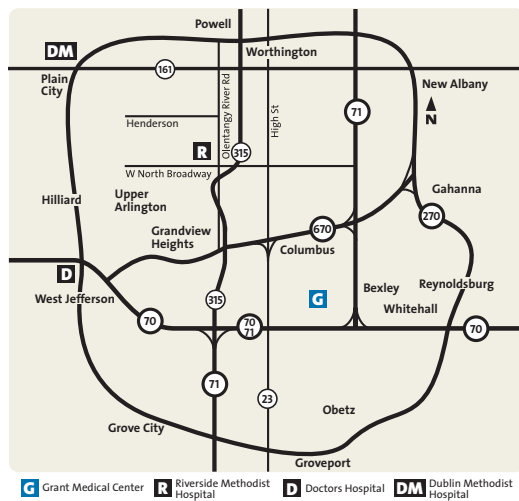

- + Follow the red path for the Emergency Department.

If you would like personal assistance, there are Information Desks in the first floor lobbies of the Main Hospital, Emergency Department, the Surgical and Heart Center and The Bone and Joint Center. If at any time you need help during your visit, go to an Information Desk or ask anyone wearing a hospital identification badge. We'll be happy to walk you to your destination.

DIRECTIONS

OhioHealth Grant Medical Center is located at 111 South Grant Avenue, at the corner of South Grant Avenue and East State Street.

From the North:

Take I-71 South to the US-40/Broad Street exit. Turn right onto East Broad Street. Take a left onto South Grant Avenue (left turn time restricted).

From the South:

Take I-71 North to I-70 East to Fourth Street. Turn left on South Fourth Street. Turn right onto East Town Street, then left onto South Grant Avenue.

From the East:

Take I-70 West to East Mound Street. Take exit 101B toward Hospital/Downtown. Continue onto East Mound Street, then turn right onto South Grant Avenue.

From the West:

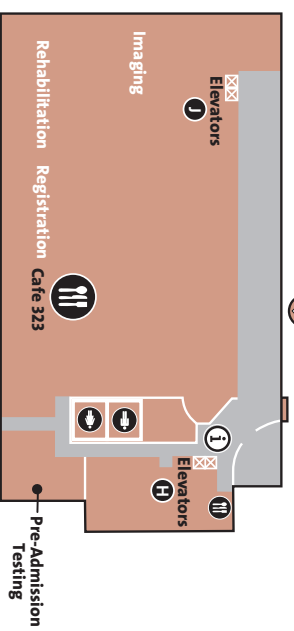
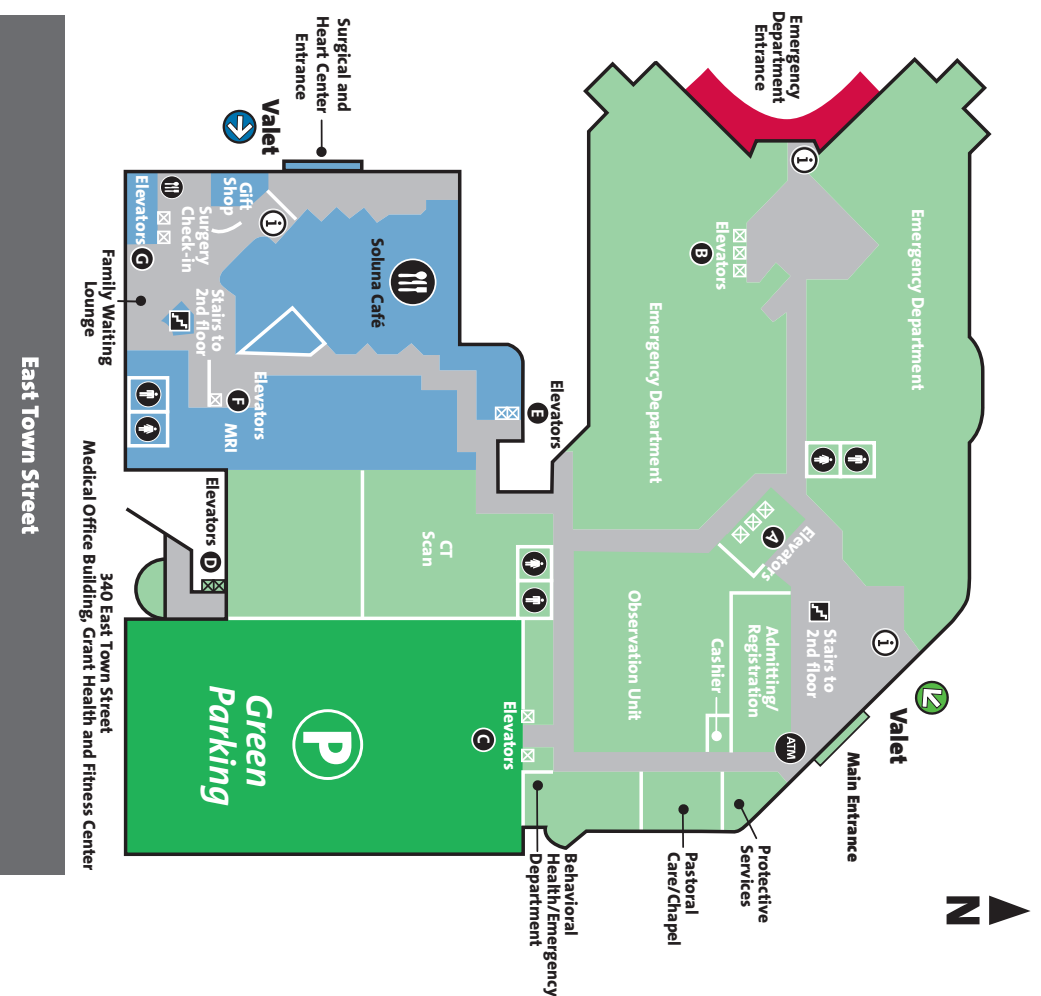
Take I-70 East to I-670 East. Take exit 4A-4B-4C to merge onto US 23 South/North Third Street. Continue on North Third Street, then turn left onto East Broad Street and then right on South Grant Avenue.

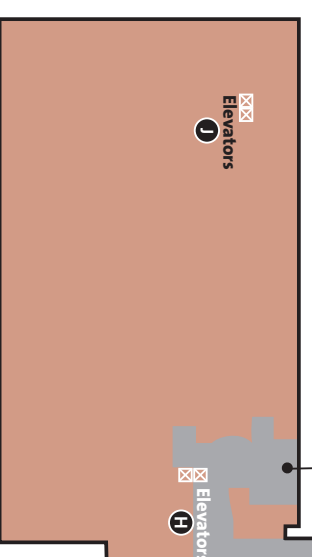
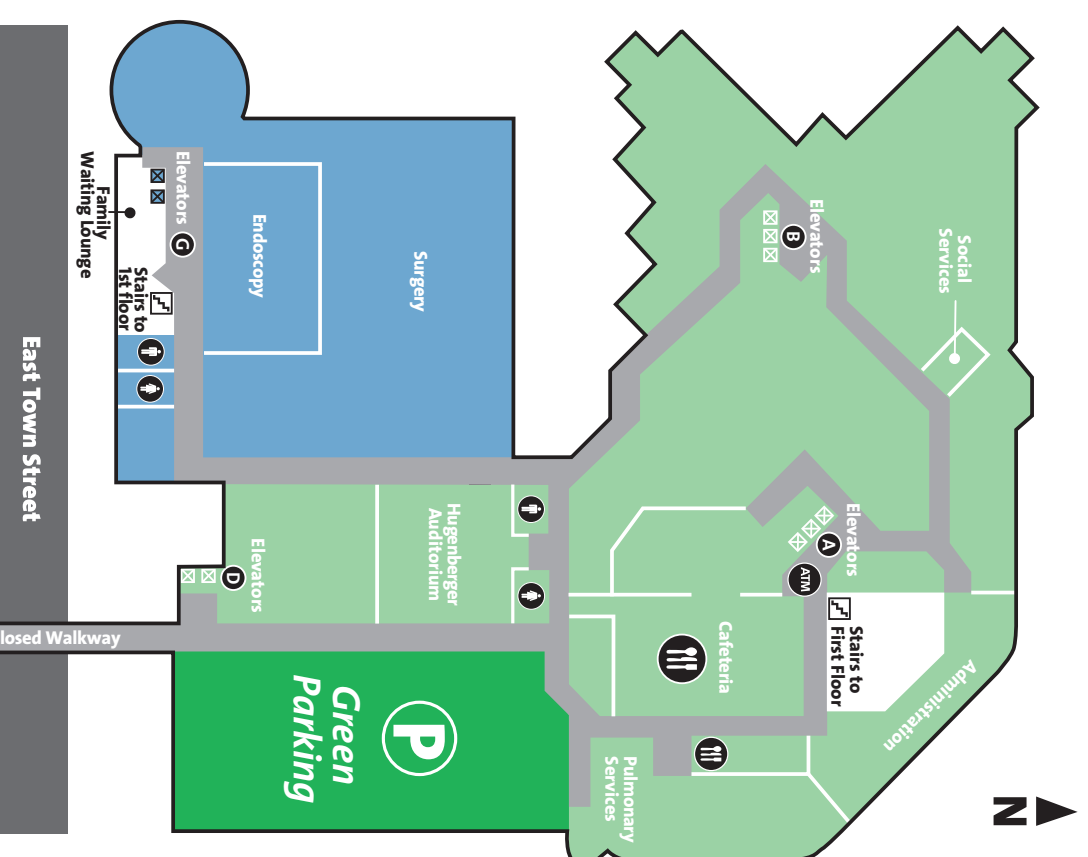

PARKING

OhioHealth Grant Medical Center offers free garage and valet parking to patients and visitors. If you park in a garage, you must take your parking ticket inside with you to have your parking validated. Parking validation is available at information desks throughout the hospital; look for signage or ask anyone wearing an OhioHealth ID badge for assistance.

Valet parking is provided at:

- + **Main Lobby**, Monday–Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m., and Saturday–Sunday, 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.
 - + **The Bone and Joint Center**, Monday–Friday, 5 a.m. to 6 p.m.
 - + **Surgical and Heart Center**, Monday–Friday, 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Parking garages are located at:**
- + Green Garage, 131 South Grant Avenue
 - + Blue Garage, 141 South Sixth Street
 - + Orange Garage, 393 East Town Street

On-street parking is available around the hospital at parking meters. Most meters are for a maximum of one hour. Handicapped parking is available in garages and on the street. If no handicapped spaces are available, ask for assistance at any of the three valet locations.
